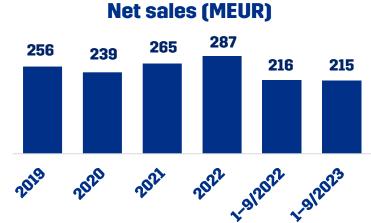

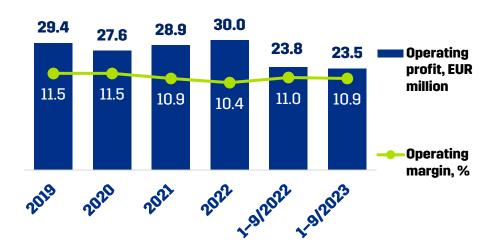

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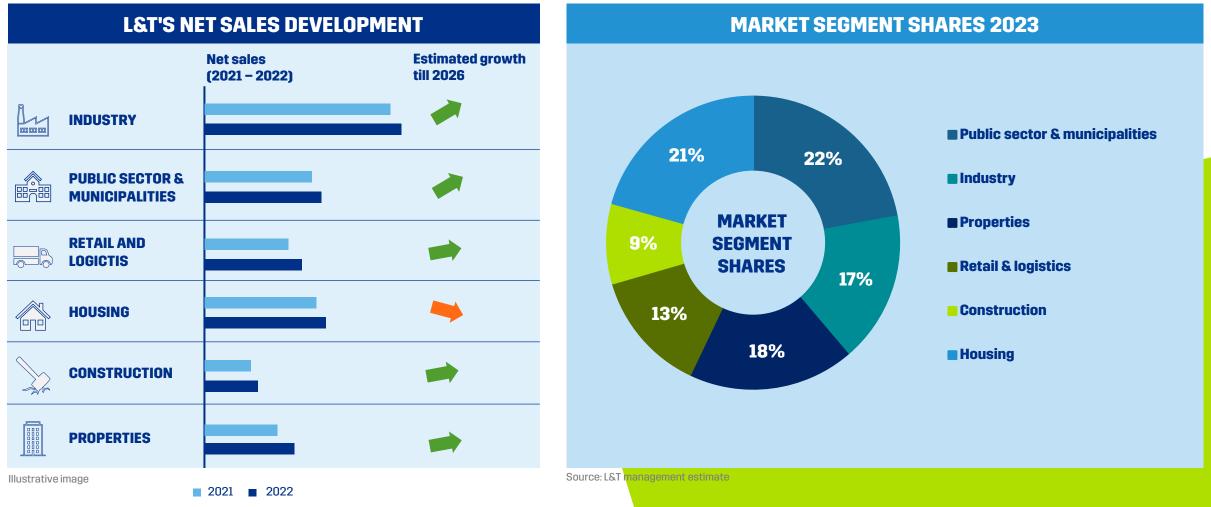
Tailwinds

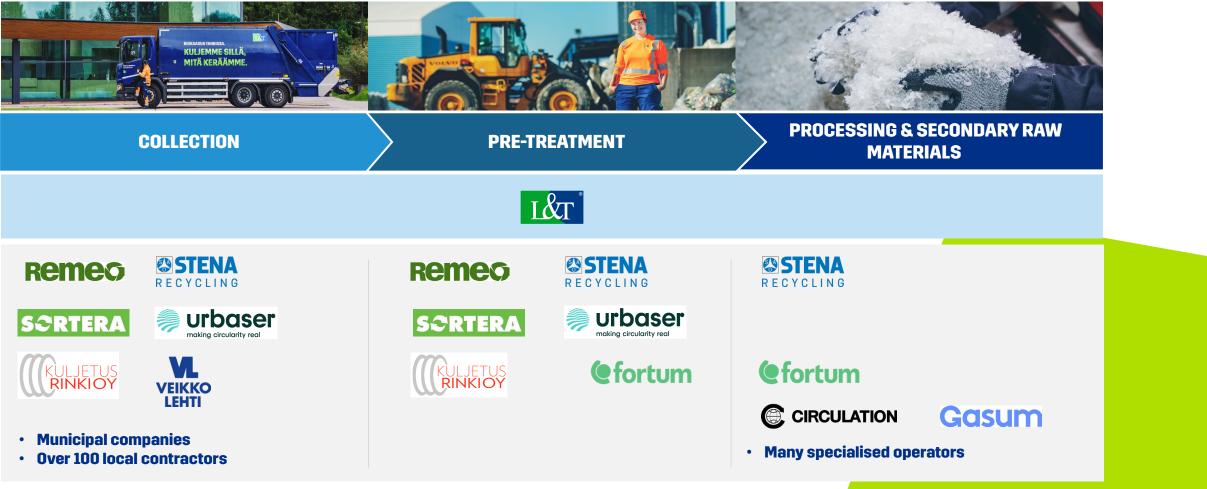

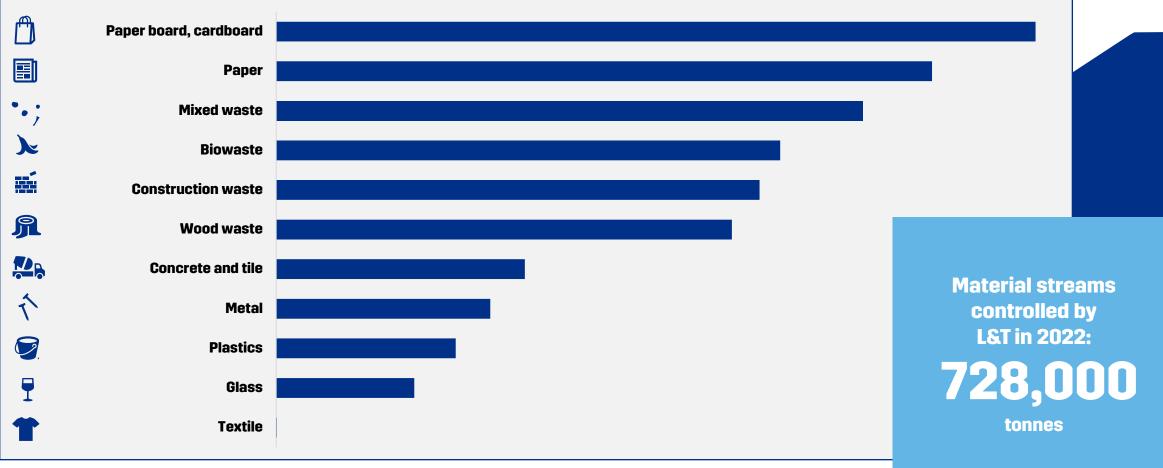

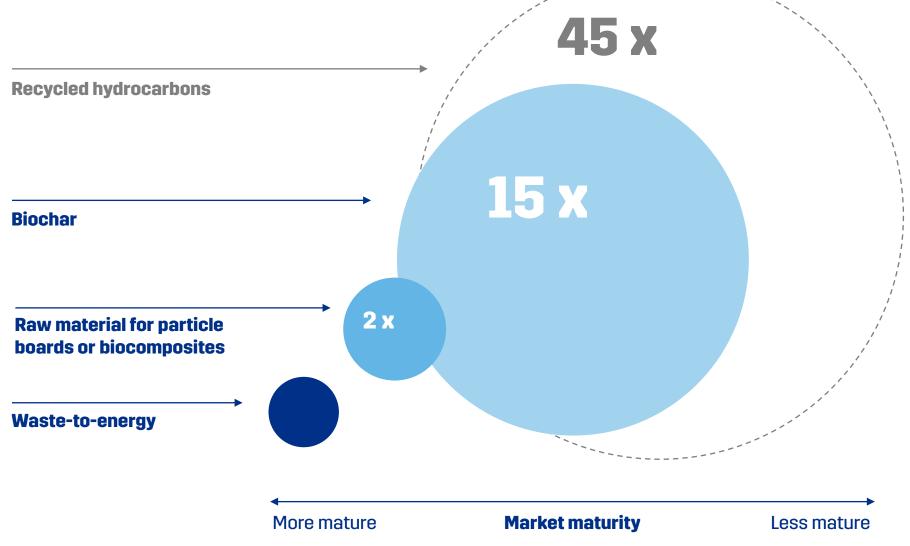

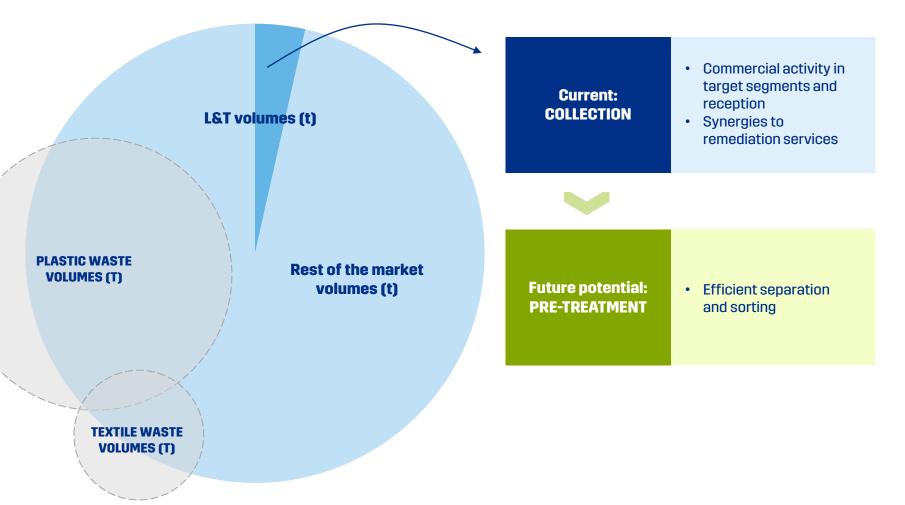


METAL RECYCLING IS A LARGE MARKET WITH HEFTY GROWTH POTENTIAL

METAL WASTE VOLUMES (T)



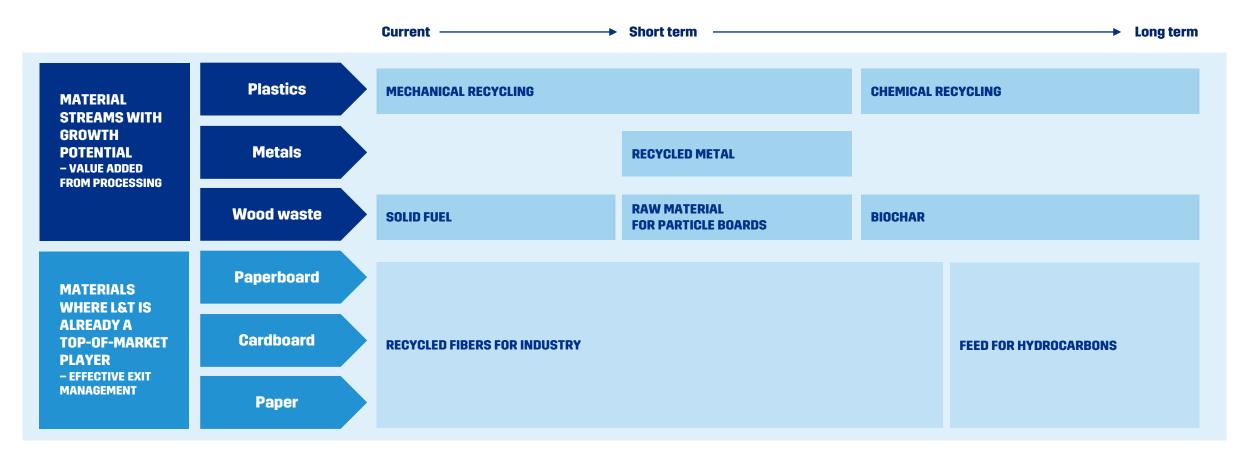
- The metal recycling market is a mature market with expected demand growth from sustainable metal production
