IN FOCUS IN Q3

- Solid performance in all divisions despite challenging business cycle
- Adjusted operating profit was EUR 31.8 million (31.3)
 January-September
- Net cash flow from operating activities after investments per share in January-September was strong at EUR 0.74 (0.03) as was L&T's financial position
- L&T announced October 25, 2023 that the Group has completed a strategy review and decided to focus on its circular economy businesses, in addition the company initiates an evaluation of strategic alternatives for Facility Services Finland and Facility Services Sweden

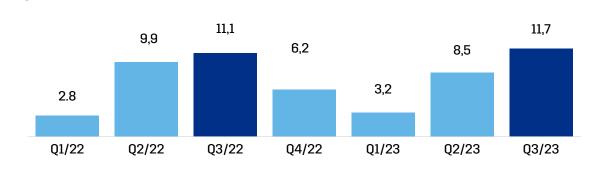

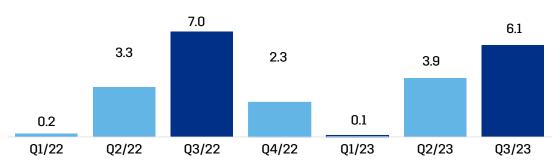
OPERATING PROFIT BY DIVISION

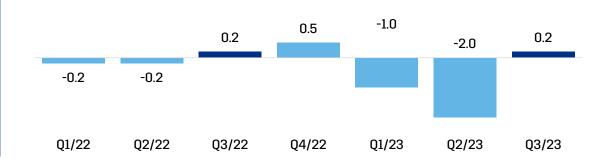

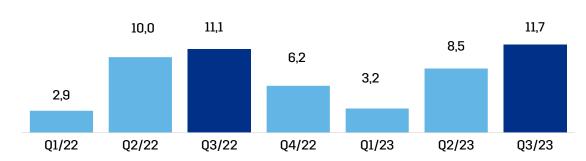




OPERATING PROFIT BY DIVISION

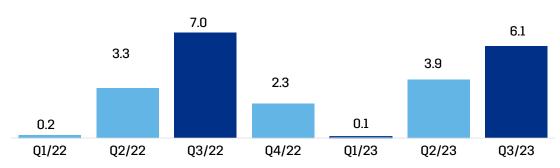

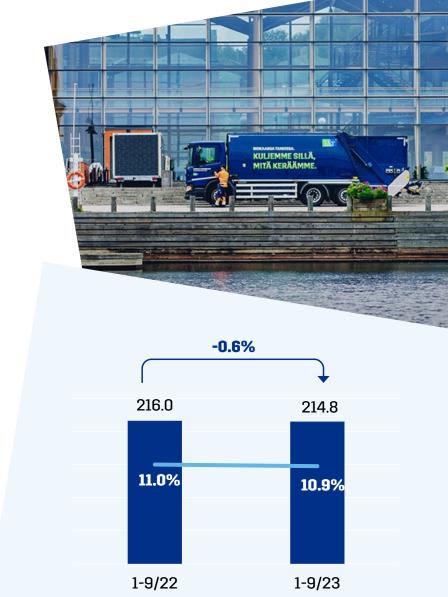

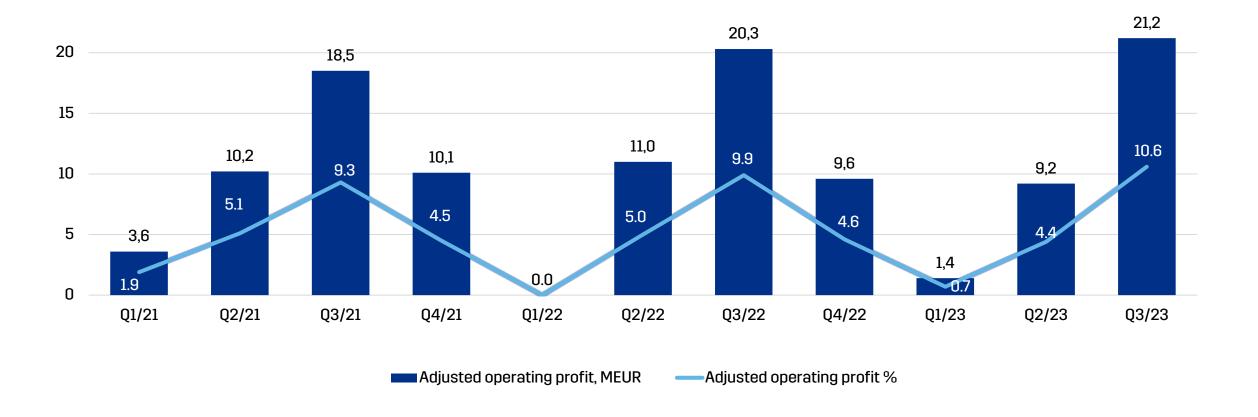

ADJUSTED OPERATING PROFIT





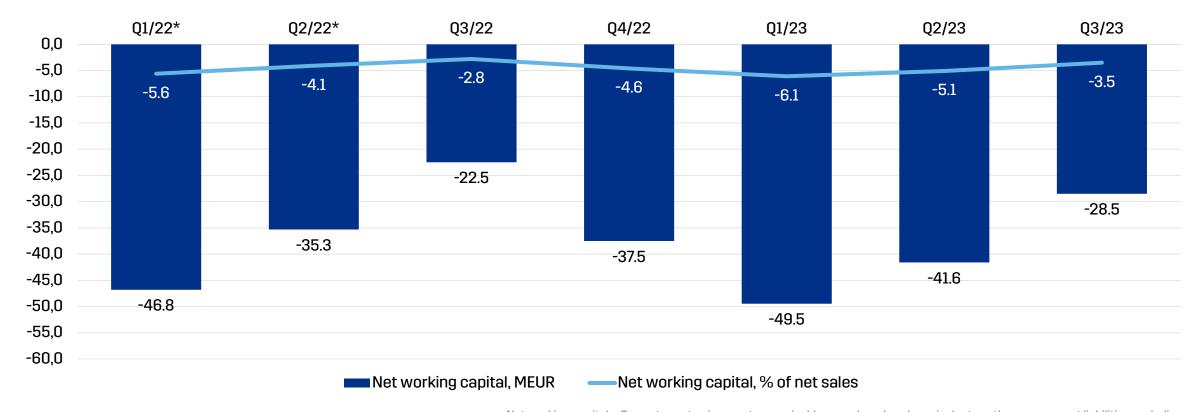

NET WORKING CAPITAL



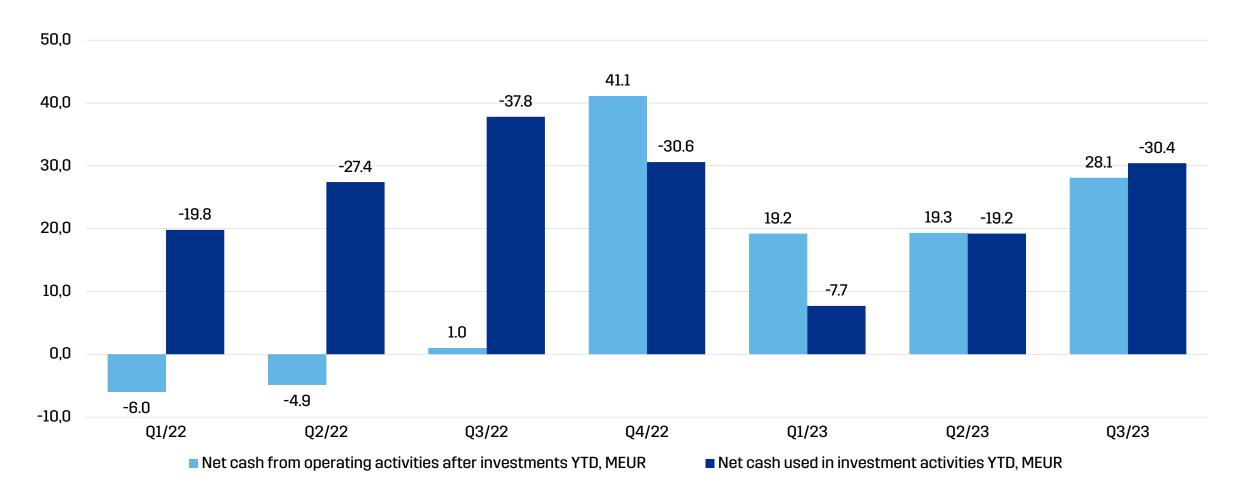

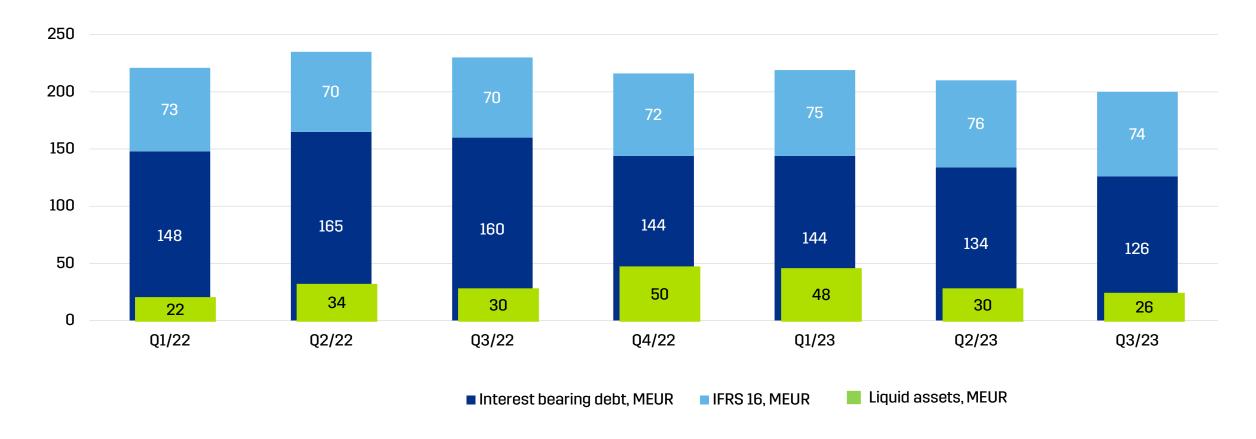

NET CASH FLOW AND NET INVESTMENTS





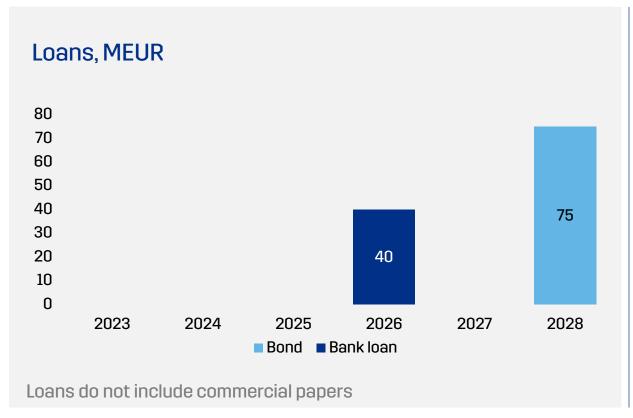
INTEREST BEARING DEBT AND LIQUIDITY

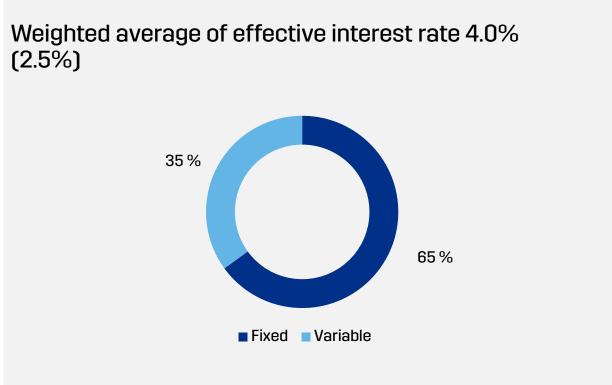




MATURITY STRUCTURE OF LOANS

L&T has repaid the remaining amount of EUR 17.7 million of the bond issued in 2018 and reduced its bank loan by EUR 10.0 million in connection with the refinancing.









OUTLOOK FOR 2023

Net sales and adjusted operating profit in 2023 are estimated to be at the same level as in the previous year even though the comparison period includes net sales from the Renewable energy sources business in the amount of EUR 35.4 million.

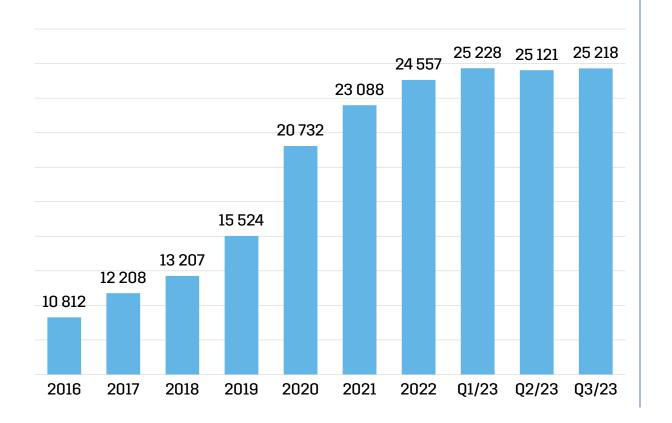

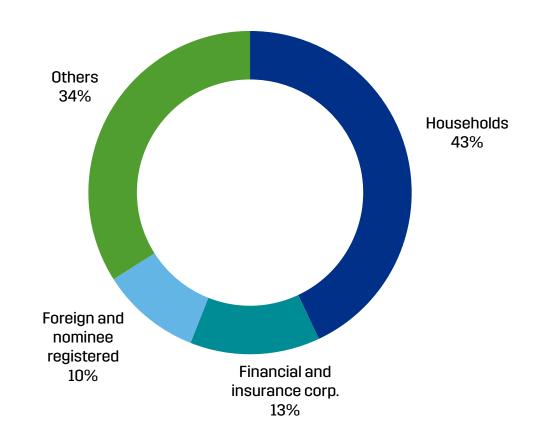


SHAREHOLDER STRUCTURE

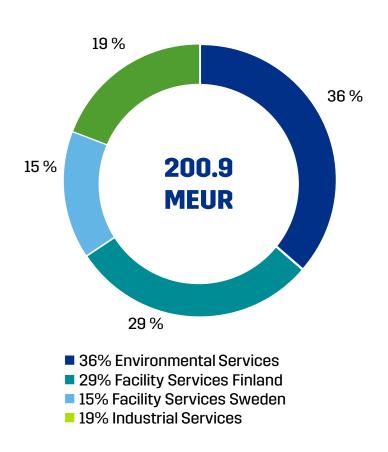
