Legal basis for and the pur- pose of the processing of per- sonal data:	The legal bases for the processing of the personal data are the legitimate in- terest of L&T's group companies and a contract between L&T's group compa- nies and the business customer or business partner.
	Personal data in the register shall be processed for the following purposes:
	<ul> <li>the management, maintenance, development, analysis of the contractual relationship between L&amp;T (or one of its group companies) and the business customer or business partner and creating statistics related to this relationship</li> <li>customer communications</li> <li>direct marketing of L&amp;T and its group companies' (including electronic newsletters), targeting and profiling of online advertisement</li> <li>conducting opinion and marketing polls</li> <li>arranging sales and marketing events</li> <li>arranging marketing competitions and prize draws</li> <li>the planning and development of L&amp;T's and its group companies' business operations and services</li> <li>customers' user identification and management and resolving errors in electronic services</li> <li>media communications</li> </ul>

Data content of the register:	The register contains the following personal data:

Regular sources of data:	The data is primarily collected directly from the data subject by telephone, online, in meetings, upon the use of services or the conclusion of the agreement or during the contractual relationship.
	Personal data may be updated and retrieved via publicly available data sources such as company web sites, the trade register, other public and private registers and various service providers (such as Suomen Asiakastieto Oy).
Regular disclosure and trans- fer of data:	Data related to waste transportation are disclosed to municipal waste man- agement authorities according to the law. Otherwise, the personal data are not regularly disclosed to third parties outside the group companies.
	L&T reserves the right to transfer the data subject's personal data to L&T's direct marketing register after the termination of the relevant connection.
	L&T uses external service providers to process personal data for the following services:
	<ul> <li>Systems maintenance, development (incl. testing) and troubleshoot- ing;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>maintaining data of business customers and business partners;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>maintaining newsletter mailing lists and sending of newsletters;</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>recording of telephone conversations; and</li> </ul>

• maintenance and processing of data of event participants.

	Each service provider processes personal data in accordance with the data processing agreement only to the extent necessary to provide the service.
Transfer of data outside the EU or EEA:	L&T and its subcontractors may process personal data outside the EU or the EEA. If the European Commission has not issued a decision on the adequacy of data protection, an agreement on the transfer of personal data in accordance with the standard clauses approved by the European Commission is generally drawn up with the service provider. As an alternative to the use of standard clauses, L&T also has the right to transfer personal data using other means of transfer permitted by legislation.
Principles of register protec- tion:	The data in the register is stored in information systems that use both techno- logical and programmatic measures to ensure the sufficient level of data se- curity. Each person using the register has a personal user name and pass- word to the system. Only designated people shall have access to the data in the register to the extent required by their tasks.
Data retention period:	The personal data in the register are stored for the duration deemed neces- sary for the purposes of the register while taking the statutory retention periods (arising from, for example, the Accounting Act and the Tax Prepayment Act) into account. The default retention period is five (5) years after the termination of the customer/contractual relationship (except insofar as is required longer by the law).
Rights of the data subject:	Right of inspection and right to request rectification or erasure of personal data
	Data subjects have the right of inspecting their personal data entered in the register. In addition, data subjects have the right to request the rectification of inaccurate data and erasure of data. Inspection, rectification and/or erasure requests must be submitted in writing by using the above contact details.
	Other rights
	According to the General Data Protection Regulation data subjects have the right to object to or request a restriction on the processing of their personal data and to lodge a complaint regarding the processing of their personal data to the data protection authority.
	The data subject shall have the right to prohibit the use of personal data con- cerning the data subject for the purposes of direct marketing, marketing or opinion surveying and profiling. Such a prohibition can be set at any time by sending email to <u>tietosuoja@lassila-tikanoja.fi</u> or, for example, by unsubscrib- ing from the newsletter according to the instructions in the newsletter.
